Water running down Sugar Street, outside school wall Ref. No. 4203828

A problem with signs from Beat Lane going through to Rudyard Lake has been passed on to C.C. G Heath

A pothole at the junction of Beat Lane and Long Edge Road has already been marked out.

Cllr. Chester is responsible for looking into the problem into wooden railings leaning near to the house belonging to Kate Brown on Beat Lane.

Is it the landowner's responsibility or S.C.C? Divided opinion

5.2 Neighbourhood Plan

Overgrown trees on footpath near to Ryecroft Gate. Owner to be informed and also the same problem on the footpath from *Royal Oak* to Sandbank Farm
